OUR SUSTAINABILITY COMMITMENT

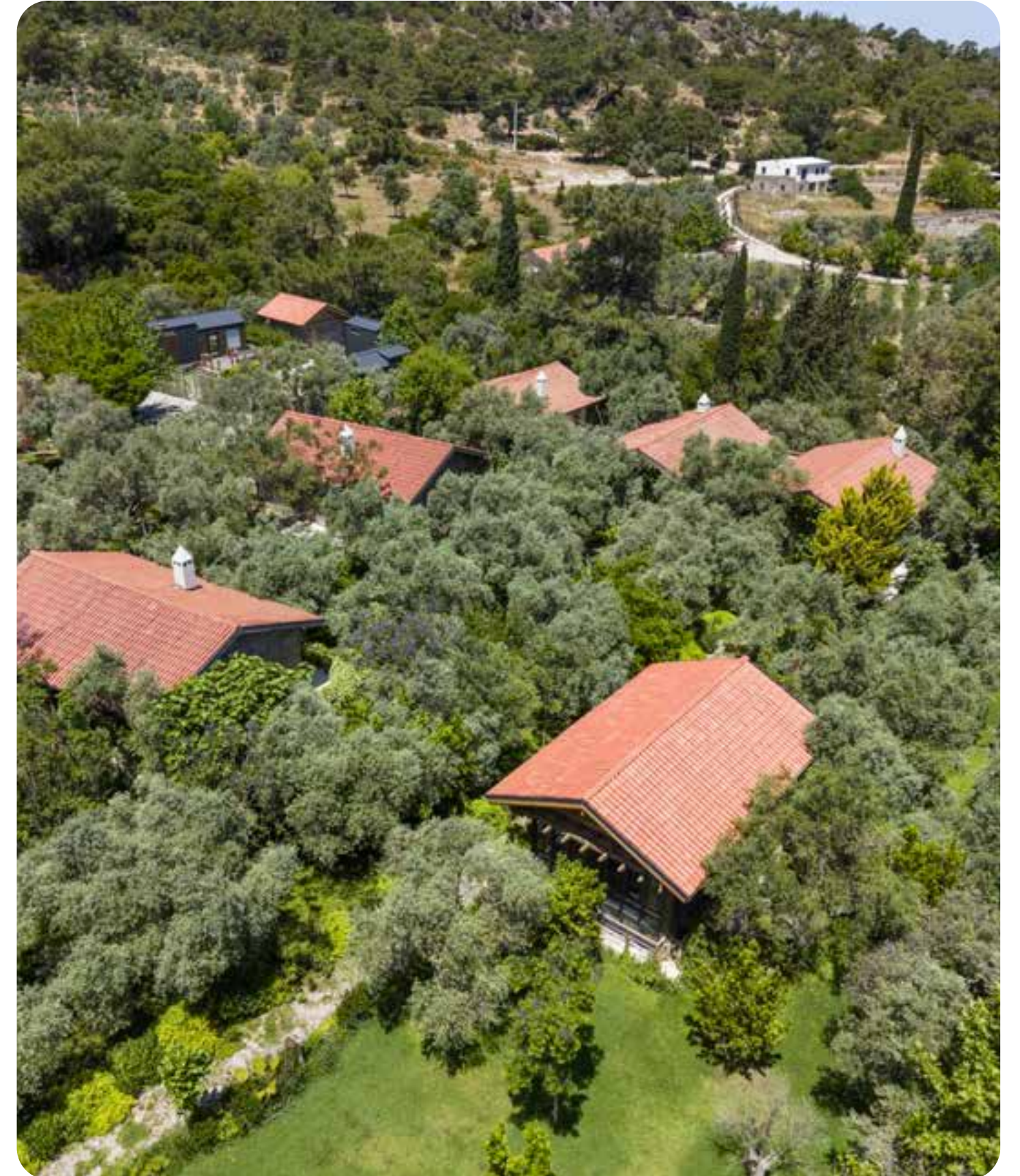
Errart Farm, set in its serene location within the ancient Lelegian lands surrounded by pine and olive trees on the Farilya hills of Bodrum, adopts the responsible use of natural resources and leaving a more livable world to future generations as a fundamental principle. As a living and hospitality space respectful of nature, humanity, art, and the region's deep-rooted cultural heritage, it regards sustainability not merely as a goal, but as an integral part of its daily operations and existence.

Grounded in energy efficiency and conscientious water management, it makes source reduction, on-site composting, and recycling of waste a natural component of daily operations. At Errart Farm, eco-friendly cleaning products are used, single-use plastics are entirely eliminated, and continuous improvement initiatives are carried out to protect the peninsula's fragile ecosystem.

Through strong partnerships established with local producers, women's cooperatives, independent artisans, and artists across Bodrum and the Farilya basin, Errart Farm contributes to the local micro-economy while offering guests the region's authentic flavors, traditional olive oil culture, and handcrafted goods. While safeguarding the region's ancient natural and cultural fabric, low-carbon transportation alternatives such as the Carian/Leleg hiking trails are promoted, and the development of sustainable agro-tourism is supported in solidarity with the local community.

Regular training sessions, workshops, and informational activities are conducted to raise the environmental awareness of our employees, resident artists, and guests. Mindful that its responsibility extends beyond the present into the future, Errart Farm operates with a service philosophy that is attuned to nature, respectful of ancient heritage, fair, and centered on human dignity.

The ultimate goal of Errart Farm is to act with an increasingly conscious approach to tourism at every step across these lands where art, production, and nature converge—thereby preserving both the peninsula's natural ecosystem and its local cultural identity to make an enduring contribution to a sustainable future.

Environmental Protection and Waste Policy

At Errart Farm , we embrace the responsibility of being located in the heart of nature and take dedicated measures to protect the natural ecosystem. Within this scope:

- Waste Management:
 - We aim to completely eliminate plastic waste and actively participate in recycling projects.
 - We reduce waste generation by offering our guests glass bottles and recyclable materials.
 - We ensure that recycling bins are easily accessible in designated areas and actively inform our guests on this matter.
- Protection of the Natural Ecosystem:
 - We prevent environmental harm through proper waste segregation.
 - We inform our guests and staff to prevent environmental pollution.
 - We participate in local clean-up campaigns to support environmental quality and biodiversity.
- Energy and Water Conservation:
 - We increase the use of renewable energy sources.
 - We implement smart water management systems to reduce water consumption.
 - We conduct awareness-raising activities among our guests and staff to protect water resources.
- Training and Awareness:
 - We provide educational materials and workshops to our guests regarding nature and environmental ecosystem conservation.
 - We deliver training programs to our staff on eco-friendly practices.
 - We collaborate with local schools on projects aimed at instilling environmental awareness in children.

Child Rights Policy

At Errart Farm , we respect the fundamental rights of children and take full responsibility for their protection. Even though our does not accommodate children under the age of 12, management assumes full responsibility for the safeguarding and protection of minors aged 12 to 17. We are committed to creating an environment that supports their physical, psychological, emotional, and social development. We recognize them as individuals, respect their rights, and protect them against all forms of abuse, exploitation, and mistreatment.

Principles of Our Policy:

- **Zero Tolerance for Child Labor:** We strictly prohibit child labor within our facility and expect all business partners to adhere to the same ethical principles. We fully comply with national and international regulations regarding the prohibition of employing individuals under the legal working age.
- **Education and Participation:** We organize educational and engaging activities to support children's learning and developmental processes. We value their opinions and take them into consideration.
- **Protection Mechanisms:** We enforce a zero-tolerance policy against child abuse. Comprehensive measures are implemented throughout our establishment against any circumstances that may jeopardize children's safety.
- **Community Support:** We take an active role in community-supported projects to enhance children's quality of life and contribute to local initiatives focused on child welfare.

- **Equality and Non-Discrimination:** We treat all children equally and do not tolerate any form of discrimination. We respect their differences and maintain an inclusive approach.
- **Prompt Intervention in Suspicious Situations:** When any form of abuse, exploitation, or suspicious conduct involving children is witnessed, hotel management is notified immediately. Where necessary, authorized official agencies are contacted to initiate formal legal procedures.
- **Recognition of Children's Rights:** Across all operations, we comply with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child and strive to protect and promote children's rights.
- **Interaction with Guest Children:** Acknowledging that close physical contact and affectionate gestures customary in Turkish culture may not be perceived the same way in other cultures, our staff are strictly prohibited from having physical contact with guest children, pinching their cheeks, using intimate terms of endearment, or offering any food or beverages directly to them.
- **Errart Farm will continue to fulfill all responsibilities to ensure children grow up in a safe world.** Creating an environment where they feel happy, healthy, and secure remains one of our foremost priorities.



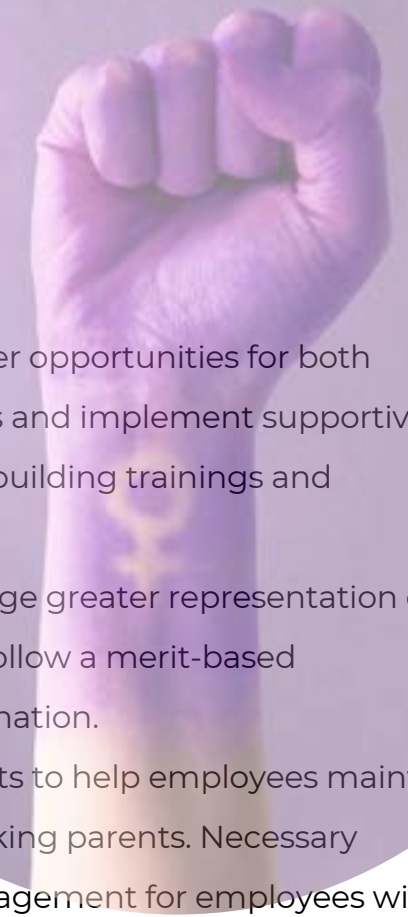
Women's Rights and Gender Equality Policy

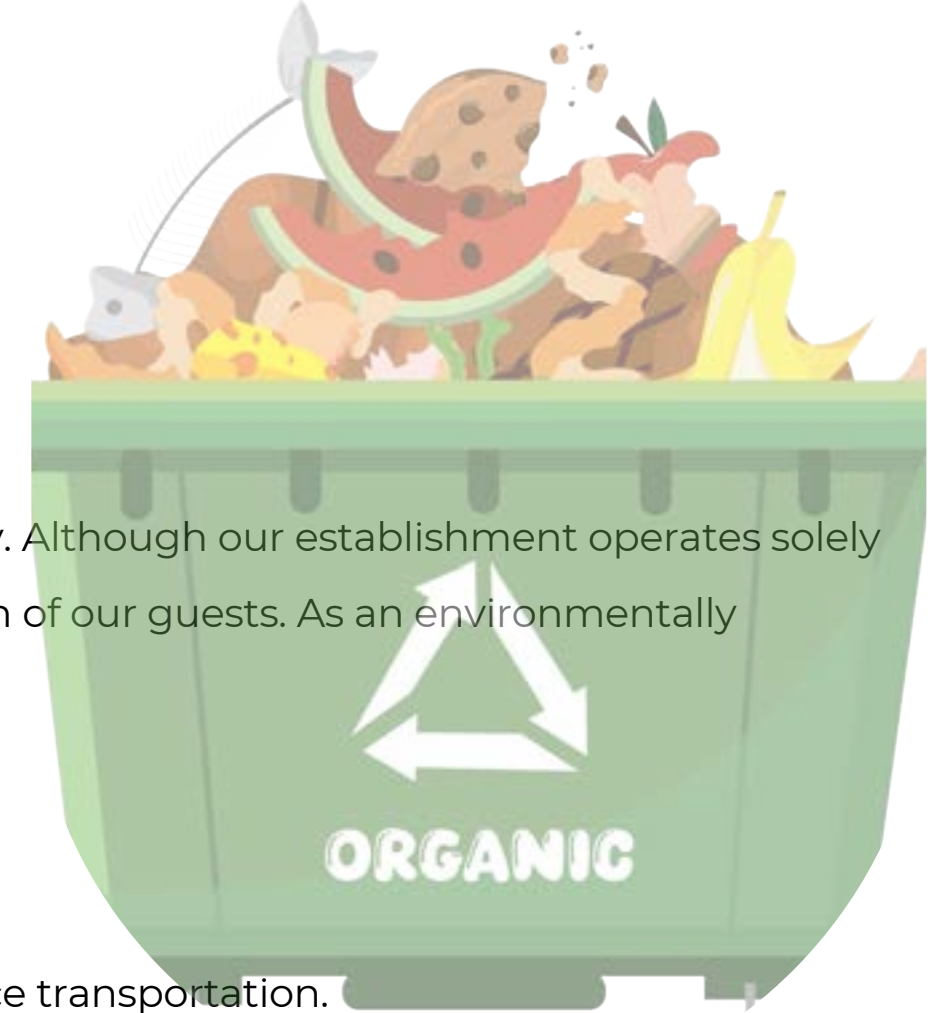
In line with this commitment:

Errart Farm Food Waste Policy

At Errart Farm, we consider reducing food waste one of our primary objectives within the framework of our sustainable tourism philosophy. Although our establishment operates solely as an accommodation facility, we aim to minimize food waste arising from both the daily needs of our staff and the individual consumption of our guests. As an environmentally conscious establishment committed to resource efficiency and social responsibility, we implement all necessary measures.

Our Operational Areas:

- 1. Planning and Procurement:
 - Food procurement for staff is planned strictly based on actual demand.
 - Local and seasonal products are prioritized to guarantee freshness and mitigate environmental impacts resulting from long-distance transportation.
- 2. Proper Storage:
 - Procured products are stored under optimal conditions.
 - Products nearing their expiration date are prioritized for consumption (FIFO principle).
- 3. Surplus Food Utilization:
 - Unused, safe-to-consume food surpluses may be shared with local animal shelters or nearby farms.
- 4. Recycling and Waste Management:
 - Organic waste is processed through on-site composting wherever feasible.
 - In cases where composting is not viable, segregated organic food scraps are distributed as feed for animals.
- 5. Training and Awareness:
 - Staff members receive recurring training and updates regarding food waste prevention.
 - Informational materials are provided to guests to raise awareness and encourage waste prevention during their own food and beverage consumption throughout their stay.
- 6. Monitoring and Continuous Improvement:
 - Food waste generated from staff operations is systematically monitored.
 - Quantifiable measurements of food waste are recorded, driving continuous improvement initiatives.

EMPLOYEES AND SUSTAINABILITY

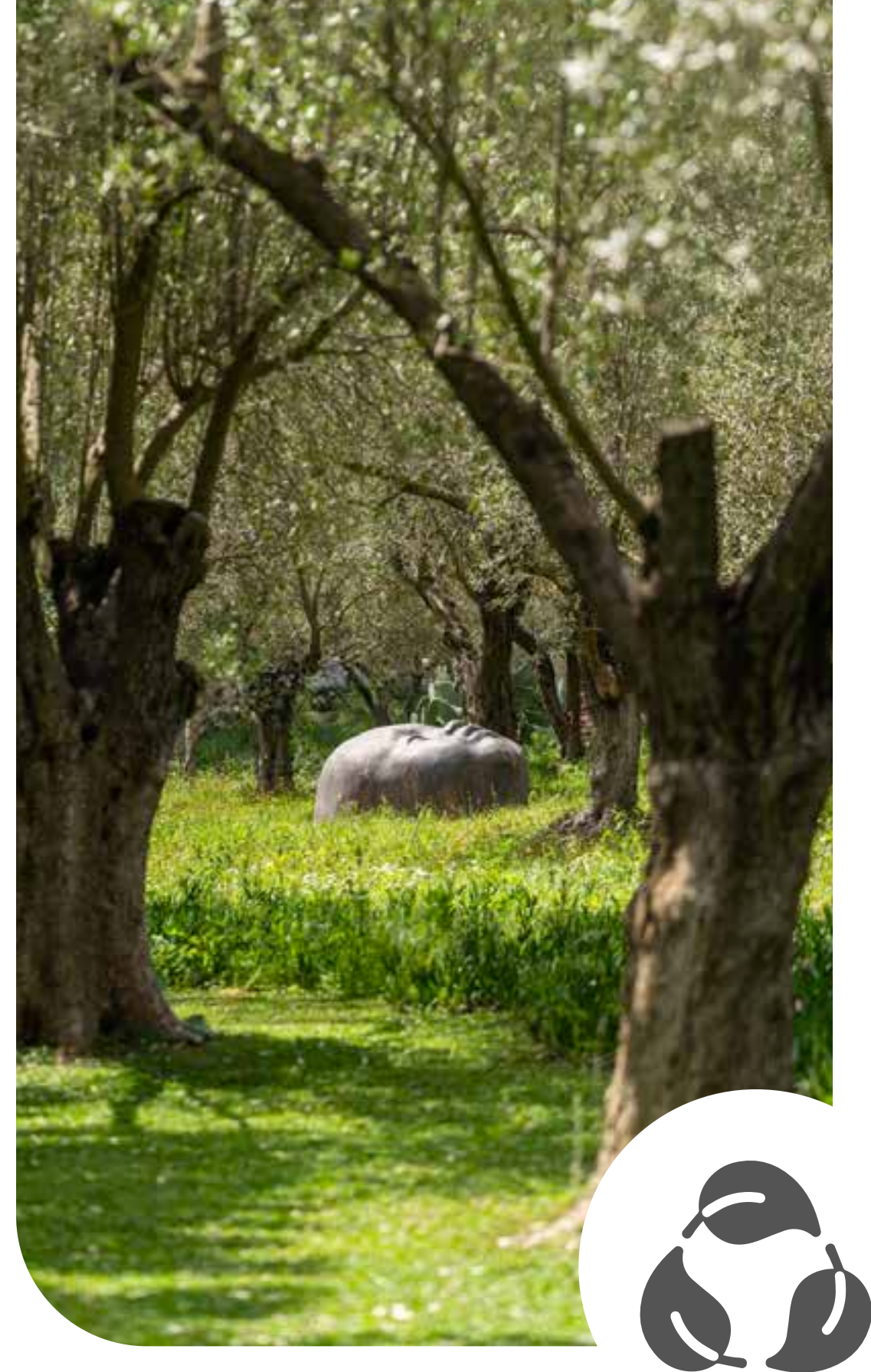
At Errart Farm, we believe that achieving sustainability goals is only possible through the active participation of our teams. In this regard, we both inform and motivate our employees by organizing training and engagement programs tailored to the natural structure, ecosystem, and local cultural characteristics of our property, which is nestled in the heart of nature.

Training and Awareness Programs In every department of Errart Farm, comprehensive training sessions are held to integrate the sustainability mindset into our daily operations. These trainings cover energy and water efficiency, waste reduction methods, recycling processes, eco-friendly practices, and the protection of the natural ecosystem. The sessions are conducted once a month in the property's common areas under the title "Green Errart Gatherings." The programs are supported by fieldwork, group evaluations, and hands-on workshops. In this way, every employee—from housekeeping to technical services—learns sustainability principles by experiencing the answers to "what, how, and why" firsthand.

Waste Management and Recycling Practices Appropriate waste collection units have been placed throughout all work and public areas at Errart Farm. Recycling and waste bins are sorted at the source using color-coded systems, such as domestic waste (blue), recyclable waste (green), and hazardous/infectious waste. During the brief "Waste Control Meeting" held every morning, the relevant department heads record the quantity and type of sorted waste. Weekly waste and recycling reports are evaluated with the participation of department managers, encouraging and educating employees to maintain similar environmentally friendly practices in their own living spaces.

Through partnerships established with the local municipality, licensed recycling facilities, and authorized disposal organizations, sorted waste is successfully integrated into the sustainable waste management chain. This process contributes both to minimizing our environmental impact and carbon footprint and to strengthening regional sustainability awareness.

With all these practices, Errart Farm aims to lead the development of sustainable tourism by fostering a conscious, participatory work culture that is attuned to nature and environmentally responsible.



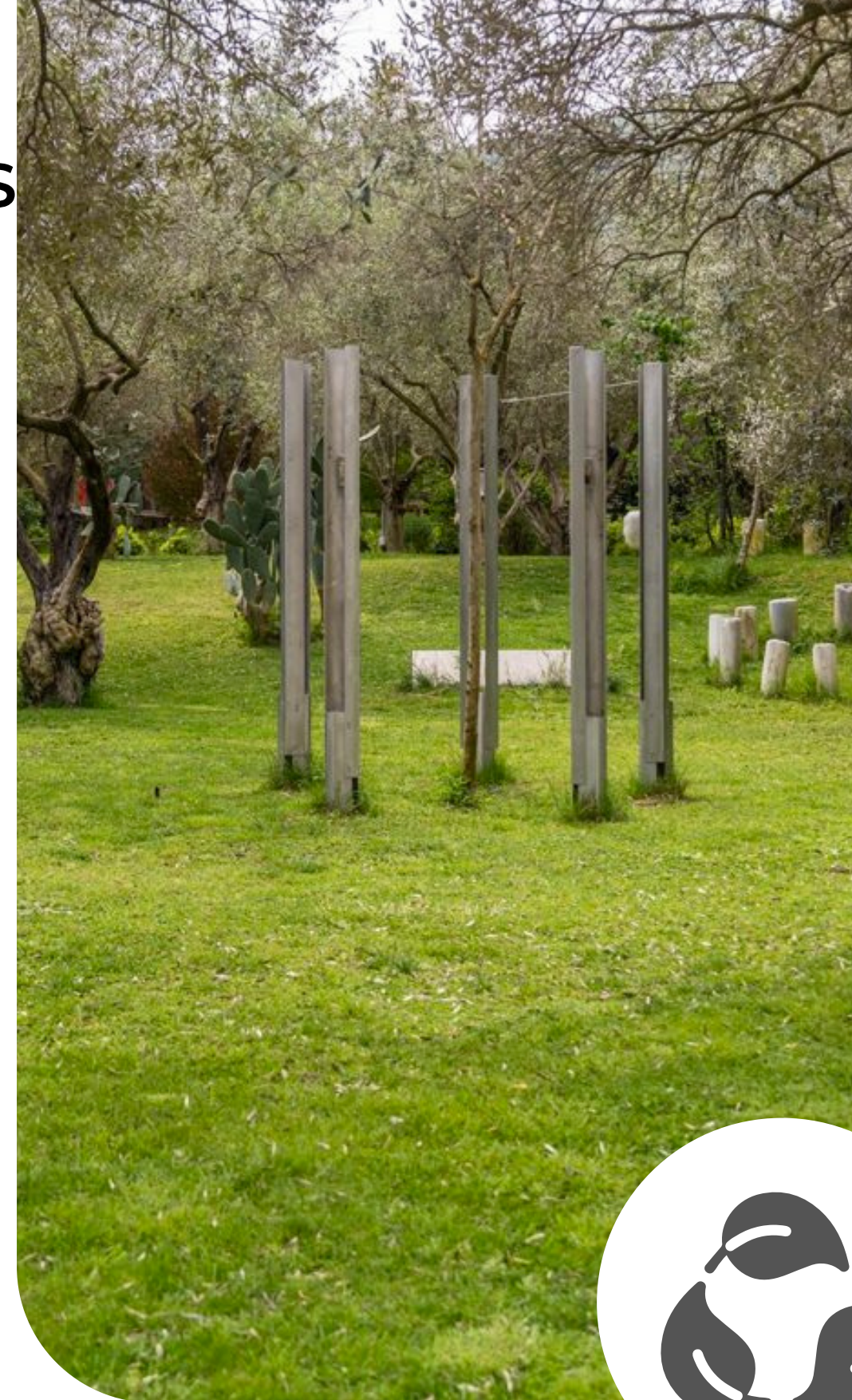
At Errart Farm, energy and water conservation is an integral part of every employee's daily workflow and responsibility. High-efficiency and sensor-activated lighting systems are used in the reception, common areas, and guest accommodations; our staff regularly monitors the effectiveness of these systems. In line with the "Energy Conservation Checklist" prepared for our teams, practices such as ensuring devices are not left on standby mode and optimizing air conditioning and heating settings throughout the day according to seasonal conditions are meticulously tracked.

Through smart water management systems and water-saving fixtures implemented across the property, consumption is regularly measured, targets are reviewed on a monthly basis, and immediate preventive measures are taken against any potential discrepancies. Our employees opt for reusable porcelain or glass cups during breaks and in common areas, aiming to eliminate single-use plastic waste entirely. These practices directly contribute both to the preservation of our natural resources and to the reduction of our property's carbon and environmental footprint.

Social Responsibility Engagement The Errart Farm team carries the responsibility of not confining its sustainability ethos within its own borders, but extending it to the local community and stakeholders. Active participation is maintained in seasonal environmental cleanup campaigns organized around our grounds and in local natural areas with our volunteer teams. Furthermore, in collaboration with local stakeholders and non-governmental organizations, an active role is played in afforestation, biodiversity conservation, and green space maintenance efforts that support the natural ecosystem.

To foster employee engagement, regular social responsibility announcements are made, volunteer rosters are established, and each colleague is encouraged to participate in social impact projects aligned with their skills. While contributing to the well-being of the local ecosystem and community, this approach also strengthens team solidarity.

Furthermore, with glass bottles and recyclable materials provided in our rooms, energy-efficient lighting, low-flow fixtures that optimize water usage, and natural ventilation options, comfort and environmental awareness are offered hand in hand. Guiding our guests toward making "green choices" throughout their stay and providing insights on protecting the surrounding ecosystem serve as core pillars of Errart Farm's sustainable service philosophy.

By offering a simple, conscious hospitality experience in complete harmony with nature, Errart Farm contributes both to cultivating a responsible tourism culture and to preserving the region's unique natural beauty and biodiversity.

The hiking paths and ancient Lelegian routes along the Farilya hills of Bodrum offer a unique trail for those seeking to explore the peninsula's pristine geography and rich biodiversity.

Where Does This Trail Lead? Starting from the ridges of Farilya and winding through olive groves, maquis shrublands, and pine forests, these natural trails provide an opportunity to become one with nature against the backdrop of the Aegean Sea and Gündoğan Bay. Paved with the enduring traces of the ancient Lelegian civilization, the stone-laid footpaths are ideal for morning strolls, nature discoveries, and leisurely jogs. Mingled with the scent of wild thyme, birdsong, and the serenity of the hills, this route offers a meditative experience that refreshes both body and mind.

How to Access from Errart Farm? Tucked away in a secluded location from coastal roads, Errart Farm (37.0512° N, 27.4398° E) serves as an unmatched starting point to step directly onto these ancient hiking routes. You can connect directly to the trails right outside your door. Guests can set out on a walk among the olive trees with the first rays of dawn, or watch the sun set over the Farilya hills to immerse themselves in the rhythm of nature. Detailed maps and guidance regarding regional hiking trails and local points of interest are readily provided by our team.

Why Is This More Than Just a Trail? This route is not merely about physical activity or taking in the scenery; it is a tangible step toward adopting a sustainable, low-carbon, and environmentally respectful way of life. Choosing walking over motorized transport minimizes your carbon footprint and helps protect Farilya's fragile ecosystem. As a crossroads where art, nature, and craftsmanship meet, Errart Farm invites its guests to become active participants in this conscious and responsible mindset.

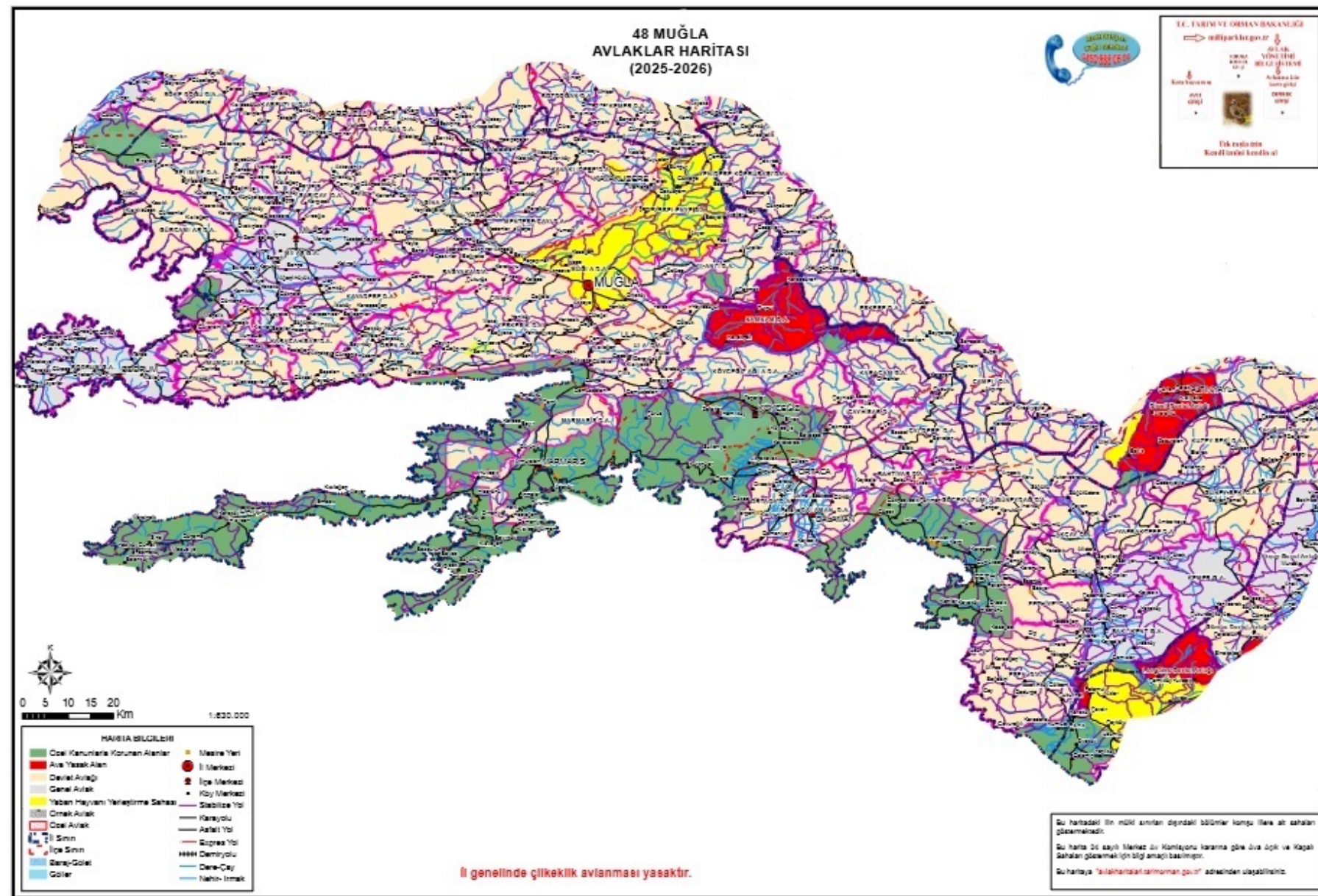

1-Resource Management and Efficiency

WATER MANAGEMENT

At Errart Farm, we act with the awareness that water is a vital resource for the Bodrum Peninsula and the fragile Mediterranean ecosystem, embracing a responsible management approach that values every single drop. With deep respect for the natural balance of the ancient Farilya hills and their olive and pine habitats, we implement comprehensive measures to minimize water consumption. Sinks, showers, and cistern systems throughout our property are equipped with low-flow, water-saving aerators and fixtures. Through this practice, substantial savings in daily water consumption are achieved without compromising the comfort standards of our guests. Informative environmental cards in the guest rooms guide our visitors to appreciate the value of water on our peninsula and to make eco-friendly choices, such as adjusting the frequency of towel and linen changes.

Technical Monitoring and Planned Maintenance To prevent unnecessary losses in water consumption, regular leak inspections are conducted across the property, and water meters are periodically monitored to detect potential leaks and sudden consumption spikes immediately. Countering Farilya's high evaporation rates, the irrigation of our agricultural and landscaped grounds is scheduled exclusively during the early morning hours or the cool of the evening; smart drip irrigation systems are utilized across all olive groves and green areas. Furthermore, the landscape fabric within Errart Farm's indoor and outdoor living spaces is curated from native and Mediterranean plant species that adapt seamlessly to the region's arid climate and require minimal water.

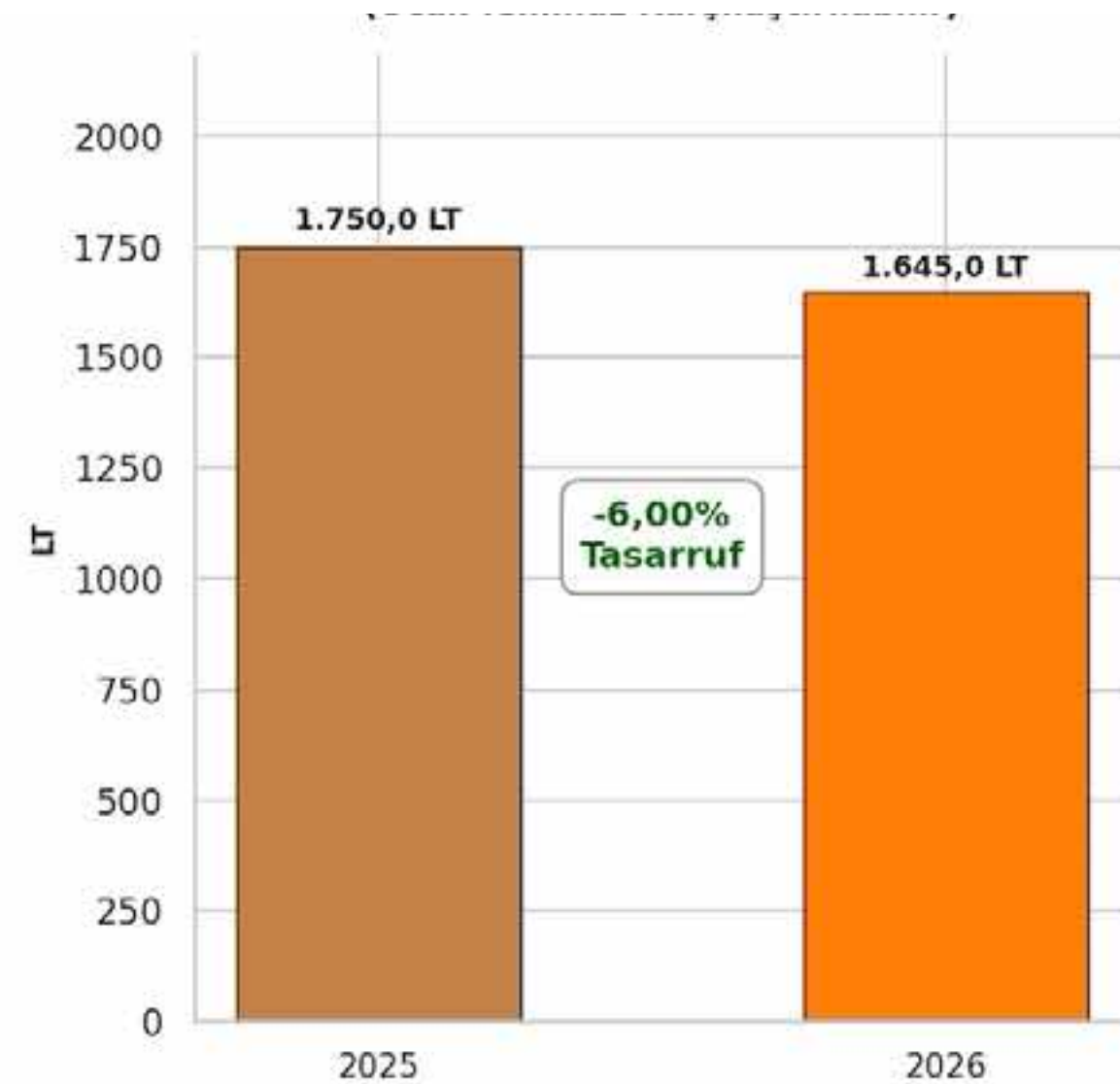
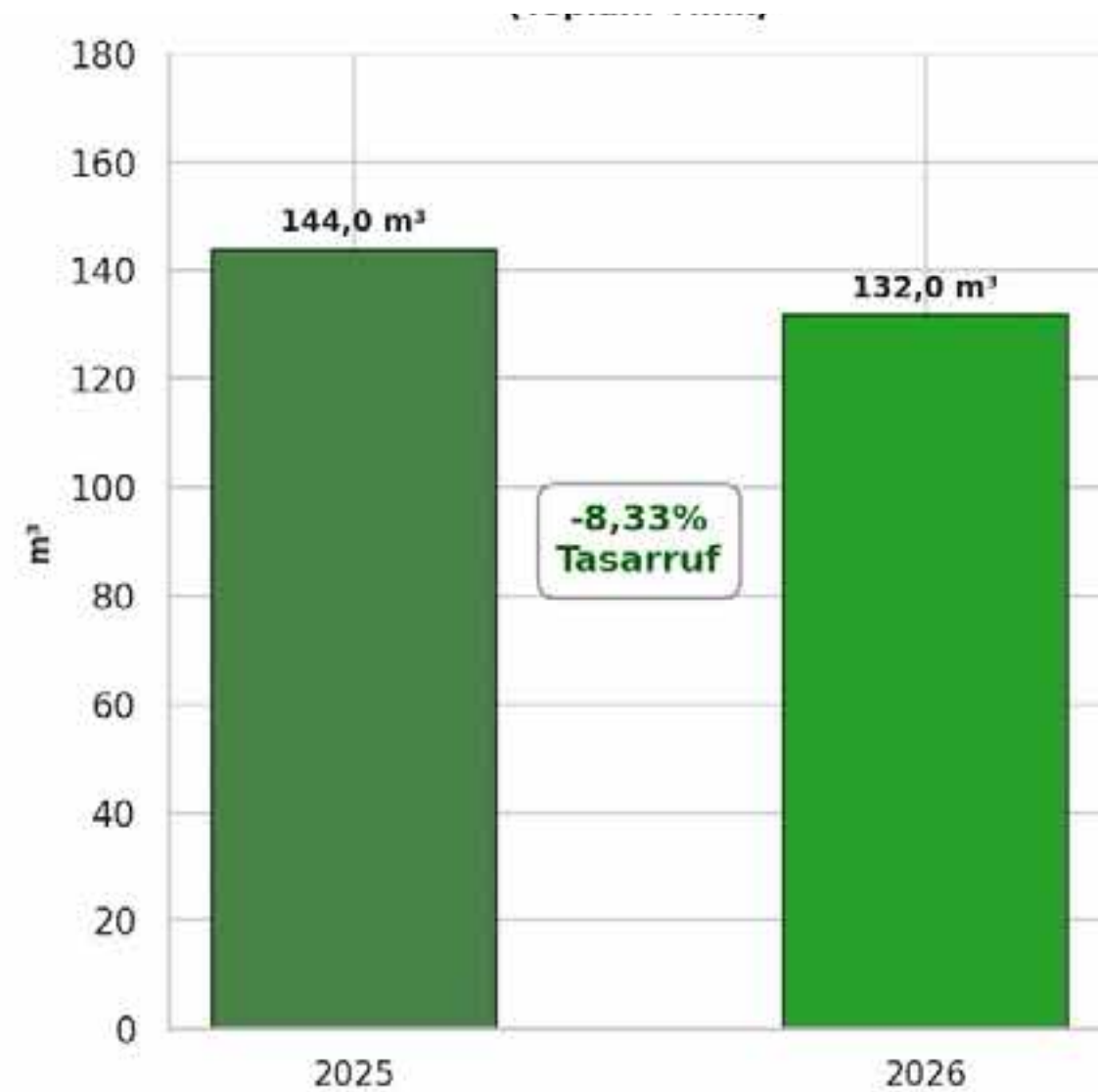
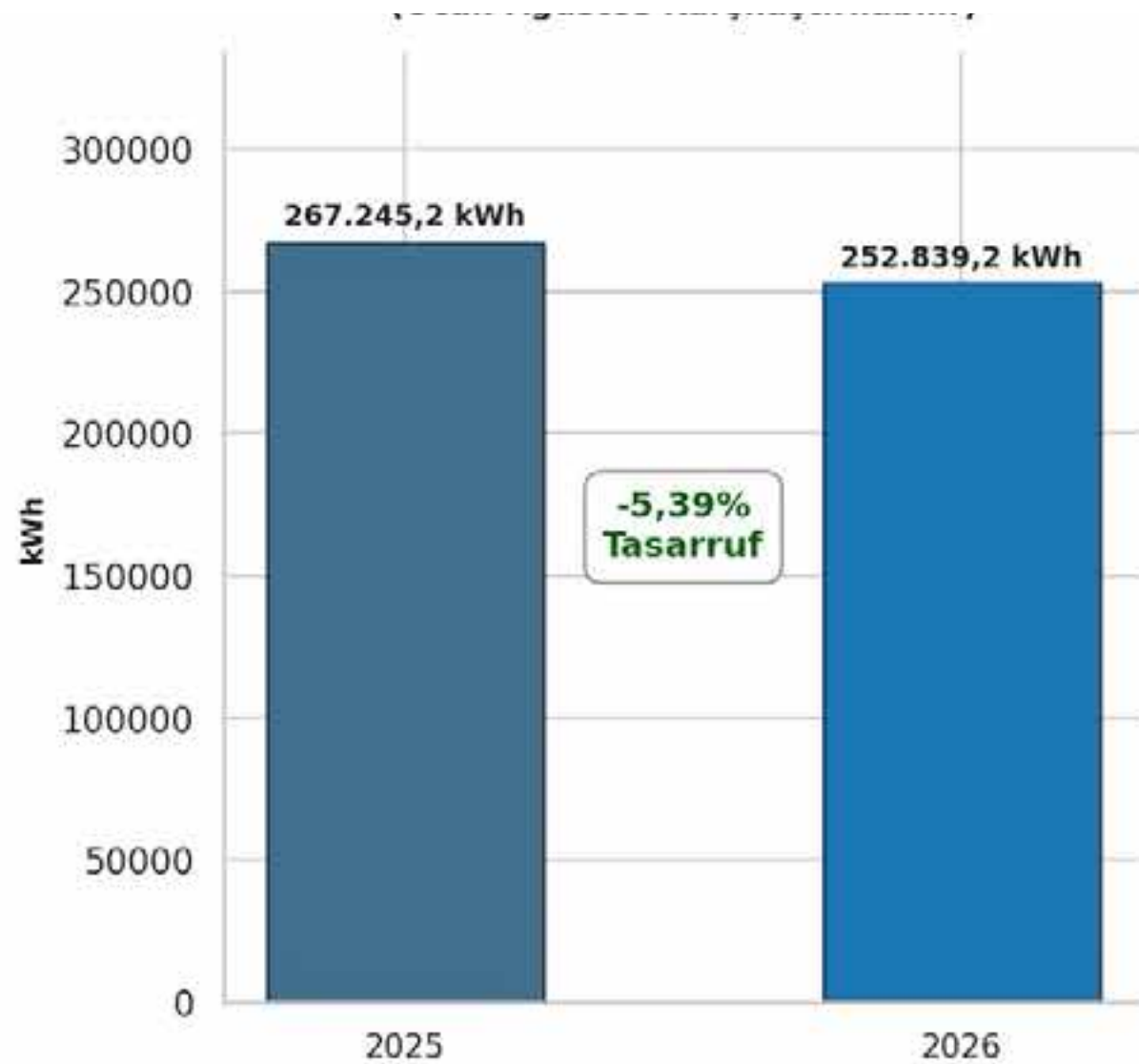

WASTE MANAGEMENT

At Errart Farm, as a reflection of our deep respect for nature and the ancient lands of Farilya, we address waste management with the highest level of rigor. To protect Bodrum's fragile peninsula ecosystem and its pine and olive cover from harm, and to utilize natural resources with utmost efficiency, we adopt an integrated and systematic approach focused on preventing waste generation at the source, minimizing output, and ensuring the precise segregation of all generated waste.

Source Segregation and Recycling Practices Across all accommodation units, open spaces, workshops, and operational facilities of our property, waste is meticulously segregated at the source by type (paper/cardboard, plastic, glass, metal, and general domestic waste) and collected in designated, color-coded recycling bins. Informative signage, directional markers, and eco-friendly visuals placed throughout common areas enable our guests to engage consciously and effortlessly in this circular process. Our team members receive continuous training on accurate waste segregation, composting processes, and environmental protection standards, taking an active and accountable role in our sustainability practices.

establishing a more efficient operational framework in terms of both cost and environmental impact.

Awareness and Training Initiatives The success of our waste management practices is reinforced not only by the technical infrastructure established, but also by the active engagement shown by our guests and team members throughout the process. To this end, comprehensive training sessions on waste segregation, source reduction, and composting practices are delivered regularly to all staff members throughout the year. Through informative materials displayed across guest areas, environmental awareness is actively maintained, encouraging the recycling of waste directly at the source.

Errart Farm remains resolutely committed to managing waste circularly without harming the peninsula ecosystem, while offering an environmentally conscious hospitality and production experience in harmony with the unique nature of the Bodrum Farilya hills.

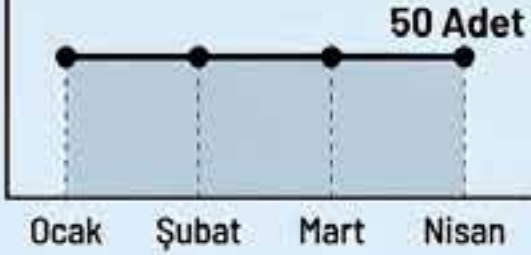

1-Resource Management and Efficiency

At Errart Farm, we aim to reduce our environmental impact and carbon footprint while ensuring long-term operational sustainability through the responsible use of energy resources. Harnessing the high solar potential, prevailing winds, and natural microclimate advantages of the Bodrum Farilya hills, we integrate energy-efficiency-driven practices across our property and farm living spaces.

Energy Efficiency Practices High-efficiency LED lighting has been standardized throughout Errart Farm, with Class-A, low-consumption appliances prioritized across all facilities. Refrigerators, water heaters, and other electrical equipment installed in guest accommodations and workshop areas have been selected based on superior energy efficiency ratings, supported by regular technical maintenance and inspection routines to eliminate losses and leaks. Furthermore, thanks to the natural ventilation, passive shading, and daylight-optimized layout provided by our traditional stone and vernacular architecture nestled among pine and olive groves, the need for mechanical climate control and overall energy consumption is kept to a minimum.

Energy Monitoring and Tracking Systems Our energy consumption is systematically tracked and metered, with quantitative data analyzed rigorously to identify operational areas holding conservation potential. By mapping the property's energy profile, conservation awareness among team members is kept active during peak operational periods, ensuring appliances are not left in stand-by mode and eliminating unnecessary energy loss entirely.

This steadfast, uncompromising approach to energy efficiency constitutes one of the cornerstones of our commitment to sustainable tourism, responsible agriculture, and conscious living across these ancient Lelegian lands.



2-Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions

Carbon Management

At Errart Farm, we act with full awareness of our ecological responsibility in the face of the climate crisis. Minimizing the environmental impacts of all operations carried out within the pristine nature of the Bodrum Farilya hills and curbing greenhouse gas emissions constitute foundational pillars of our sustainability approach.

Low-Carbon Operational Approach At Errart Farm, priority is placed on energy efficiency and low-emission principles across daily operations. Periodic technical maintenance is rigorously conducted on the heating and cooling systems of our living units nestled among pine and olive trees, supported by operational controls that prevent redundant HVAC usage. High-efficiency LED lighting has been standardized throughout the property, and Class-A energy-efficient equipment is prioritized. Our core objective is to deliver maximum operational performance across these ancient lands with minimal resource and energy consumption.

Emission Reduction in Transportation and Logistics Situated along a peaceful valley ridge away from coastal traffic and arterial roads (37.0512° N, 27.4398° E), Errart Farm encourages both staff and guests to limit individual motorized vehicle use. By promoting routes highlighting ancient Carian and Lelegian trekking trails, pedestrian-friendly wayfinding, and optimized local public transit/transfer planning, we support a low-carbon hospitality and agro-tourism experience. Furthermore, prioritizing local producers in our procurement processes directly limits supply-chain emissions associated with long-distance freight.

To make a direct positive contribution to the socio-economic fabric of Bodrum and Farilya, we forge partnerships with local producers, prioritizing small businesses, women entrepreneurs, and traditional craftspeople across our procurement and purchasing operations.

Support for the Local Economy and the Arts

Decorative objects, natural textiles, and consumable supplies utilized throughout Errart Farm's living spaces, accommodations, and farm areas are procured from local producers, artisans, and craft workshops. At our property—a junction where art, nature, and production converge—in-house artist residencies and collaborations with local creators are brought to the fore. By amplifying the visibility of Bodrum-based producers, artisans, and artists, we support original work in reaching broader audiences. This approach strengthens the peninsula's local economy while offering our guests the opportunity to experience firsthand Farilya's ancient cultural fabric and authentic local craftsmanship.

Community Engagement and Volunteering

Errart Farm actively supports team members participating as volunteers in corporate social responsibility initiatives across Gündoğan, Farilya, and greater Bodrum. We foster strong ties with the local community, agricultural cooperatives, and local chambers of agriculture. Staff participation is prioritized in coastal and trail cleanups, the stewardship of heritage olive groves, indigenous sapling planting drives, and local social solidarity activities. This engagement enhances public environmental awareness while deepening local belonging and mutual solidarity.

Cultural Sustainability

Mindful of our roots in ancient Lelegian lands, Errart Farm creates spaces that showcase local olive-cultivation culture, traditional Aegean farming practices, and regional handicrafts. We promote all-natural products from local producers and guide our guests toward cultural events and trekking routes along Carian and Lelegian heritage trails. In doing so, both our team members and visitors establish a direct, meaningful connection with the peninsula's deeply rooted cultural legacy.

Errart Farm's philosophy of social sustainability extends beyond direct economic contributions; it embodies an inclusive, enduring vision committed to strengthening local relationships, uplifting independent artists and producers, and preserving ancient cultural heritage.





4- Corporate Social Responsibility Projects

Cultural Sustainability

At Errart Farm, we offer our guests more than just a peaceful and comfortable stay; we provide an authentic experience where art, production, and nature intertwine, allowing them to truly sense the enduring spirit of Farilya and the ancient Lelegian lands. In line with our cultural sustainability ethos, extensive partnerships and awareness initiatives are conducted to preserve, document, and promote the historical and artisanal values unique to the Bodrum Peninsula and the Farilya basin.

Access to Local Art,

Craft, and Culture To highlight the peninsula's ancient cultural heritage, Errart Farm cultivates collaborations with local craftspeople and independent creators, directly dedicating space across our living areas to showcase ceramics, sculpture, painting, wood carving, and traditional handicrafts. Through in-house artist residency programs, open workshops, and cultural gatherings, we amplify the visibility of local producers, artists, and women entrepreneurs, enabling our guests to forge deep, genuine connections with the region's living artistic expressions.

Natural, Archaeological, and Cultural Discoveries

For guests seeking to immerse themselves in Farilya's millenary olive groves, pine forests, and traditional rural life, comprehensive guidance is provided on ancient Lelegian and Carian trekking routes, antique rock-cut tombs, Peynirçiçeği Cave, and regional cultural heritage sites. By championing pedestrian-first exploration over motorized transit, we both safeguard Farilya's fragile ecosystem and help ensure the transfer of local cultural heritage to future generations.

Direct Contribution to the Local Economy and Craftsmanship

Decorative appointments, natural home textiles, and botanical personal care products utilized across Errart Farm's accommodations and shared areas are preferentially sourced from women's cooperatives, local producers, and artisan studios across Bodrum and Farilya. Furthermore, visits to regional farmers' markets, artisanal olive oil mills, local stonemasons, and art galleries are actively encouraged among our guests.

Responsible and Value-Driven Tourism

Errart Farm embraces a responsible agro-tourism model centered on community and cultural well-being, actively partnering with sustainability-driven local initiatives and agricultural/cultural platforms. By empowering local producers, independent creators, and community members, we contribute directly to sustaining a resilient, distinctive, and vibrant communal fabric across the Bodrum Peninsula, both economically and culturally.

5- Local and Impactful Procurement

At Errart Farm, we prioritize local, circular, and eco-friendly procurement practices as an integral pillar of our sustainability vision. As a living sanctuary situated across the ancient hills of Farilya—where art, nature, and agricultural production intersect—we structure our supply chain processes to minimize environmental impacts, curb freight-related carbon emissions, and directly empower the local-cultural development of the Bodrum Peninsula.

Priority to Local Producers and Suppliers Textiles, cleaning and maintenance supplies, and architectural restoration materials utilized across Errart Farm are predominantly sourced from local producers in Bodrum, Gündoğan, and surrounding basins. This approach supports the peninsula's micro-economy and regional suppliers while driving logistics-related greenhouse gas emissions down to a minimum.

Responsible Supplier and Environmental Standards Our partners and suppliers are evaluated not merely on pricing and quality parameters, but also against strict social responsibility standards, including eco-conscious manufacturing methods, waste reduction, avoidance of hazardous chemicals, and adherence to fair labor practices. We forge long-term, trust-based partnerships with stakeholders who minimize plastic packaging, provide recyclable or biodegradable packaging solutions, and employ energy- and water-efficient production processes.

Support for Independent Artists, Artisans, and Women's Labor Artistic objects, handwoven textiles, ceramics, and decorative details integrated into Errart Farm's architecture, guest units, and farm areas are acquired directly from local artisans, independent studios, and original works created through our in-house artist residency programs. Bodrum's traditional stone and wood craftsmanship, handcrafted goods from local women's cooperatives, and works by independent regional artists sit at the very core of our procurement chain. In doing so, we foster a fair-trade environment that honors labor while directly sustaining the region's living artisanal heritage.

Holistic Contribution to Cultural and Regional Development Through artist residencies, open workshop programs, and collaborative production initiatives, Errart Farm provides a visible platform for regional creators and local handcrafts. Heirloom seeds and all-natural products that preserve Farilya's olive-growing heritage, aromatic flora, and traditional cultivation culture are prioritized across all operations.

Through this integrated procurement model, Errart Farm not only lowers its environmental footprint, but also directly advances the long-term vitality of art, nature, and community well-being across the Bodrum and Farilya basin.



6- Support for Local Entrepreneurs

Support for Local Entrepreneurs and Artists

At Errart Farm, we embrace a holistic perspective on sustainable agro-tourism and responsible hospitality that addresses not only environmental priorities, but economic and social dimensions as well. As a living sanctuary situated across the Bodrum Farilya hills—where art, nature, and agricultural production intersect—we make the empowerment of local residents, regional independent artists, craftspeople, and micro-entrepreneurs an integral element of our daily operations.

Priority to Women Entrepreneurs and Producers

To bring visibility to women's labor, strengthen economic independence, and advance equal opportunity, Errart Farm gives clear priority to products crafted by women entrepreneurs and women's cooperatives. Handmade artisan soaps crafted from local Bodrum olive oils, botanical personal care products, traditional handwovens, ceramics, and natural decorative objects are integrated throughout our property, providing tangible backing to women's active role in regional economic development.

Promoting Local Production,

Artist Residencies, and Regional Culture Dedicated showcase and experiential spaces have been created at Errart Farm to introduce and honor the heritage unique to the peninsula and the Farilya basin. Within these settings, the heritage narratives of regional olive-growing traditions, endemic aromatic flora, and time-honored artisanal crafts are shared directly with our guests. In addition, our in-house artist residency programs, open studio workshops, and local maker gatherings provide an immediate platform for works by independent artists and handcrafted goods made by local residents, helping guests forge genuine ties with the distinctive cultural fabric of the ancient Lelegian landscape.

Through these practices,

Errart Farm does not simply stimulate the micro-economies of Farilya and greater Bodrum; it delivers enduring, active support toward foundational social responsibility priorities including gender equity, the safeguarding of living craft traditions, and fair trade.

7- Women's and Children's Rights

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Errart Farm Protection of Women's and Children's Rights

Protection of Women's and Children's Rights At Errart Farm, we consider the protection and safeguarding of women's and children's rights a foundational pillar of our sustainability policies and corporate ethical values. We maintain a sensitive, uncompromising, and responsible stance toward ensuring gender equality and upholding the right of children to grow up in a safe, healthy environment shielded from every form of harm.

Equal Opportunities and Local Employment for Women Errart Farm provides full and equal opportunities for female team members across recruitment, training, career progression, and leadership roles, cultivating a fair, respectful, and inclusive workplace anchored in the principle of "equal pay for equal work." Women are actively encouraged to take decisive roles in managerial decision-making and operational leadership. Furthermore, to reinforce regional socio-economic development, priority is given to the employment of local women residing in Farilya, Gündoğan, and greater Bodrum. A strict zero-tolerance policy is enforced against all forms of gender-based discrimination, coercion, and harassment.

Child Safeguarding, Safety, and Rights Errart Farm respects and upholds the fundamental rights of children in full alignment with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. Even though our property does not accommodate children under the age of 12, ensuring the physical, emotional, and psychological safety of adolescent guests aged 12–17, as well as all youth within our community, remains the full responsibility of our management. We maintain an absolute zero-tolerance policy toward child labor, abuse, neglect, and exploitation. To protect personal boundaries and cultural sensitivities, staff interactions with visiting youth—such as physical contact, overly familiar address, or offering unauthorized treats—are governed by strict operational protocols. Any suspected violation or safeguarding concern triggers immediate internal escalation and official reporting to legal authorities.

Awareness and Collaboration with Local Civil Society To foster deep institutional awareness regarding women's and children's rights, comprehensive training sessions are provided regularly to our team members, complemented by informative communication throughout guest areas. We actively partner with local women's cooperatives, women's advocacy groups, and child welfare non-governmental organizations across Bodrum and Muğla, lending operational and platform support to community education and social responsibility initiatives.

8- Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse

At Errart Farm, ensuring the physical and psychological safety of our guests, artists, and team members across our living sanctuary—where art, nature, and production converge in the Farilya hills—is one of our most fundamental responsibilities. Across our property and farm grounds, an uncompromising zero-tolerance policy is enforced against sexual abuse, harassment, exploitation, workplace mobbing, and all forms of violence. Such acts are recognized not only as legal offenses, but as grave violations of fundamental human rights.

Awareness and Training To safeguard institutional awareness and corporate ethical values, our staff receives regular training and briefings, reinforcing that violence, abuse, and discrimination of any kind are strictly prohibited within our organizational culture. All necessary preventive administrative and operational measures are rigorously implemented to maintain a safe, equitable, respectful, and inclusive working and hospitality environment across Bodrum's ancient Lelegian landscape.

Confidential Grievance and Reporting Mechanism In the event that any discomfort, harassment, violence, or suspicious conduct is experienced or observed, our guests, artists, and team members can report the incident through secure, transparent, and strictly confidential channels. Dedicated grievance mechanisms are in place to ensure direct access to property management. All submissions are handled with the highest degree of discretion and sensitivity; necessary internal investigations are executed without delay, and legal proceedings are initiated with judicial authorities whenever warranted.

A Property Committed to Human Rights Respect for human dignity and human rights constitutes the foundation of Errart Farm's corporate identity and sustainability vision. Providing a fair, equitable, and respectful atmosphere where guests feel at peace and secure, and where staff rights are fully safeguarded, remains our highest commitment. This approach guarantees the sustained vitality of a human-centric, ethical, and safe community culture throughout all operations at Errart Farm.

9- Decent and Respectable Work

Errart Farm operates in full compliance with International Labour Organization (ILO) conventions, the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and the principles of the United Nations Global Compact. Across all operations conducted at our sanctuary in the Bodrum Farilya hills—where art, nature, and production intersect—unwavering adherence to human dignity, fair working conditions, and transparent corporate ethical standards is fundamental.

Prohibition of Forced Labor and Human Trafficking All our team members are employed entirely of their own free will; no employee shall ever be subjected to forced labor, debt bondage, coercion, threats, physical or psychological disciplinary measures, or human trafficking practices. Employees retain sole and absolute possession and control over their legal identity documents, travel papers, and personal employment files.

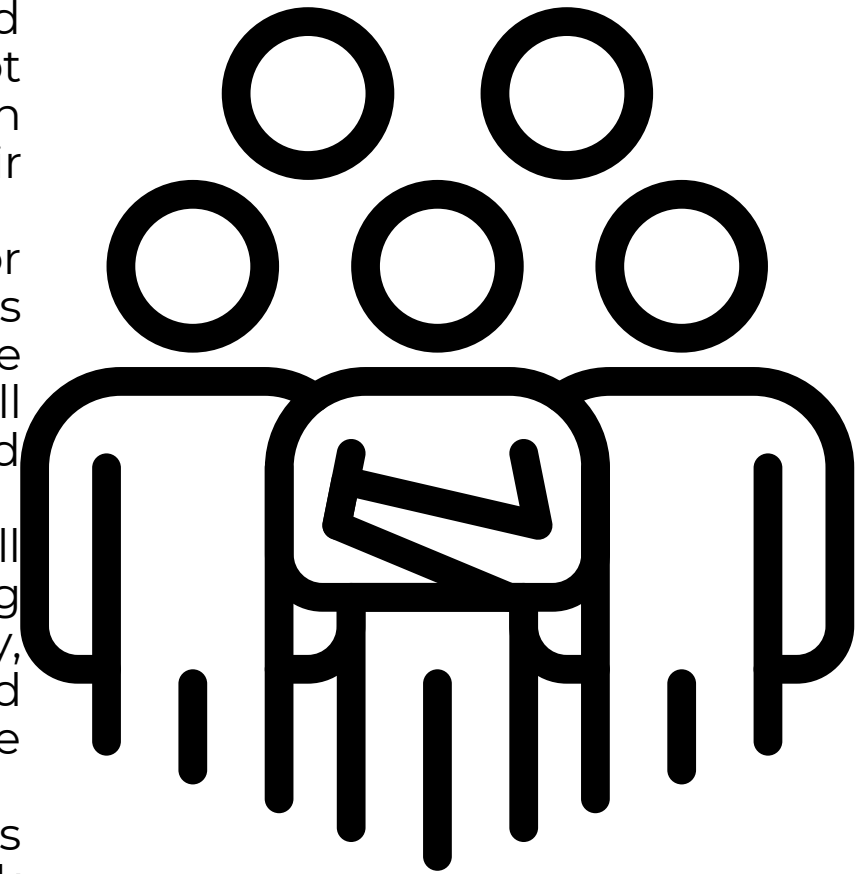

Comprehensive risk assessments are conducted periodically across our farm, workshops, kitchens, and guest accommodations; team members receive continuous training in occupational health, safety, and fire prevention protocols to achieve continuous improvement under a zero-accident philosophy.

Working Hours, Fair Remuneration, and Social Benefits Working hours, weekly rest periods, and statutory annual paid leave are strictly regulated in full conformity with applicable labor legislation and international standards. Our compensation structure is governed by the principle of "equal pay for equal work," providing a fair, transparent, timely, and decent living wage that surpasses statutory minimum requirements.

Guided by these ethics-driven principles, Errart Farm remains steadfast in sustaining a work culture that honors human dignity and is inherently fair, equitable, and sustainable.



At Errart Farm, in alignment with our sustainability management system, we commit to preserving the ancient nature of the Bodrum Farilya hills and bequeathing a more livable world to future generations.

With full awareness of our environmental and social responsibilities, we pursue continuous improvement through the active participation of our guests, artists, and team members.

Our property's primary objectives include:

- Minimizing environmental and social impacts on the Bodrum Peninsula ecosystem,

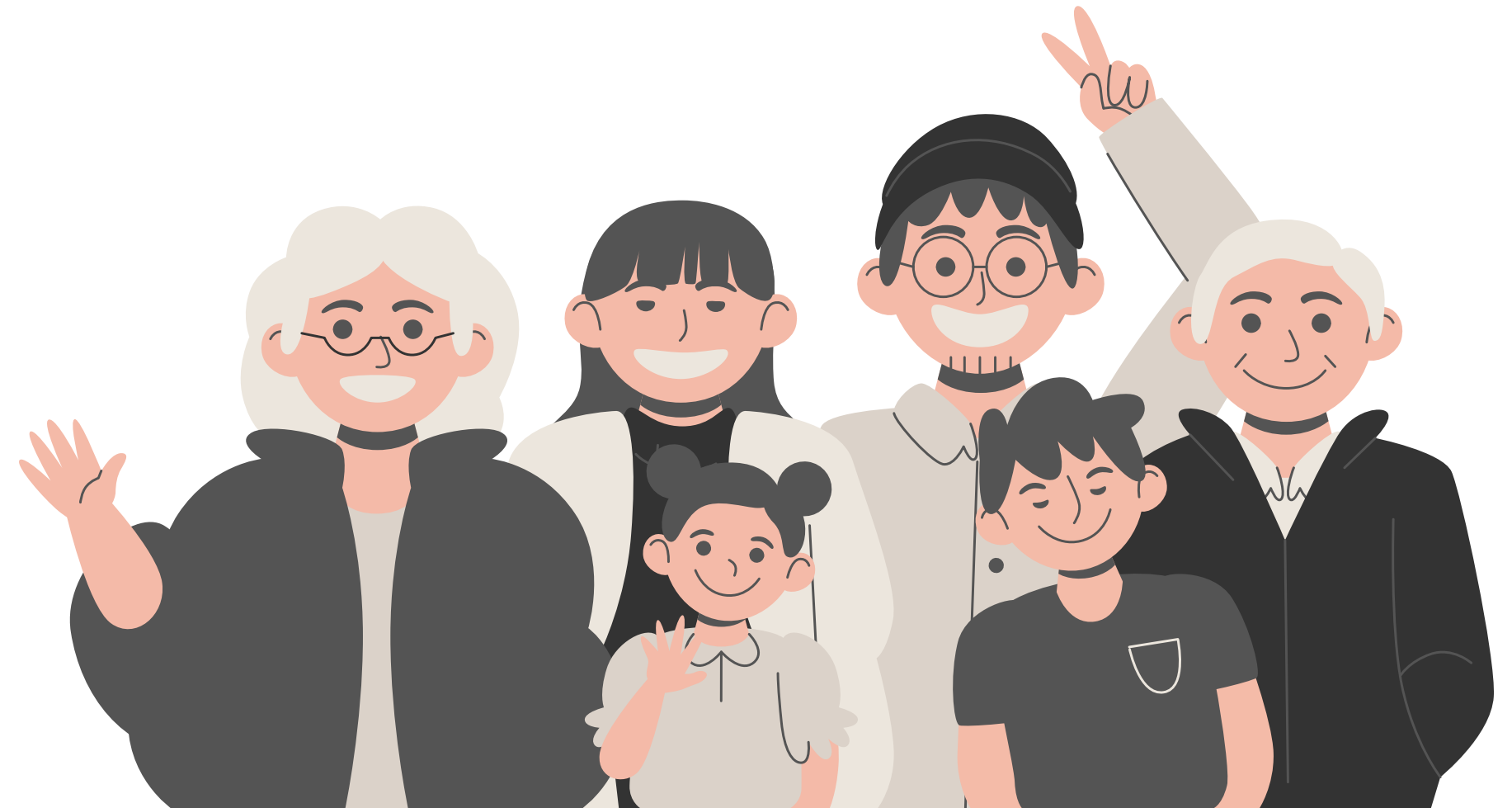
Through this appointment, our property aims to collaborate with local communities to more effectively realize our environmental and social sustainability targets.
